

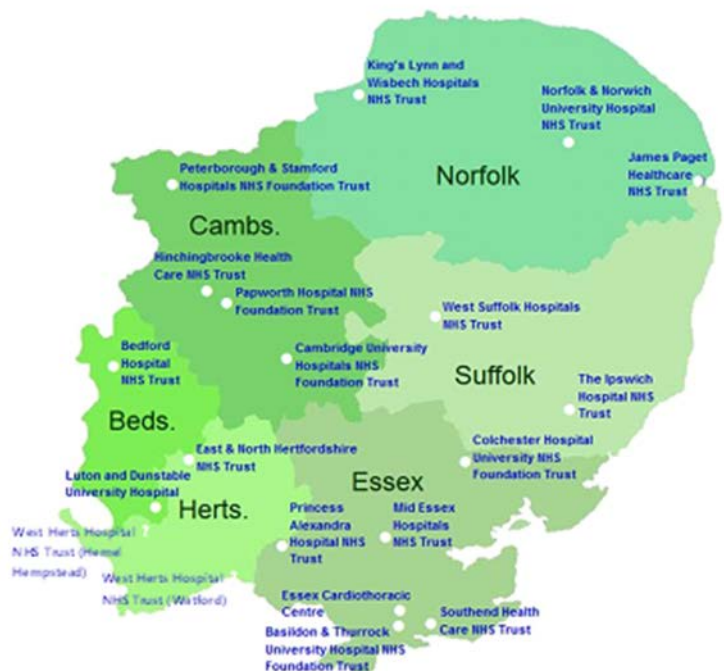


Clinical Senate Assembly Members' Bulletin July 2018
