Offer 2: Support Clinical Senate will support commissioners and providers with independent clinical advice and involvement in major change projects, i.e. being a place to have enable and have safe conversations with other clinicians and stakeholders on service change	<ul> <li>Any of above projects may result in a request from commissioners to for independent clinical review of major change programmes identified. To support this:</li> <li>National toolkit under development.</li> <li>National task and finish group working on senate's role following the closure of National Clinical Advisory Team.</li> </ul>
Offer 3: Thought Leadership Clinical Senate will proactively provide clinically driven advice and thinking on areas for service improvement or where a whole system strategic response is required	East of England Clinical Senate will identify a small number of topic areas where it can add value by working proactively to provide advice (to be confirmed by June 2014).
<ul> <li>Measurement will be through the following success criteria:</li> <li>i) Commissioners and providers understand who the senate is and when they can request advice</li> <li>ii) Senate provides a timely response to requests received</li> <li>iii) Advice provided is found to be appropriate and useful by those who commissioned it</li> </ul>	Governance Overseen through the following governance arrangements: Hosted by NHS England Area Team with an accountability and governance framework to ensure that process and procedures are robust. Clinical advice offered is independent. All advice provided will published in Senate Annual Report and to public facing website
