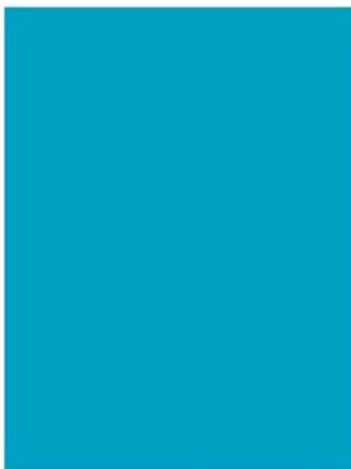

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## **Declaration of Interests**

It is a requirement that NHS appointed chairs and board directors should declare any conflict of interest that arises in the course of conducting NHS business. Although a non-statutory body, NHS England East of England Clinical Senate has adopted these principles and Senate Council members should expect to comply with the same requirements as board directors in other NHS bodies.

All NHS organisations maintain a register of member's interests to avoid any danger of board directors (Senate Council members) being influenced, or appearing to be influenced, by their private interests in the exercise of their public duties.

All Senate Council members are therefore required to declare any personal or business interest(s) which may influence, or may be perceived to influence, their judgement. This should include, as a minimum, personal direct and indirect financial interests (including regular employment), and should normally also include such interests of close family members. Indirect financial interests arise from connections with bodies which have a direct financial interest, or from being a business partner of, or being employed by, a person with such an interest.

It should be noted that best practice principles are that the interests of voting members of the Senate Council to be in the public domain, it is considered good practice for all members who speak at the Council and can therefore influence decisions to declare their interests.
